### Rules and Regulations of the Great Neighbors' Duck Races

The Great Neighbors' Duck Race is a raffle fund raising event for Neighbors, Inc., a nonprofit agency under the 501 (c)(3) status of the Internal Revenue Service. Tax ID # 41-1360294. Great Neighbors' Duck Race complies with all Minnesota Gambling Control Board requirements.

- 1. By entering the raffle, all winners agree that their names and likenesses can be used for promotional purposes by Neighbors, Inc. with no additional compensation. All decisions and interpretations of rules and regulations will be made by Neighbors, Inc. and their judgment is final. A copy of the rules and regulations will be made available to any person through written request, with a stamped and self-addressed envelope provided by the requestor, at Neighbors, Inc. address of record.
- 2. Adoptions, at \$5 apiece, can be purchased from members of The Great Neighbors' Duck Race Neighbors Staff. All bounced checks will be returned to the buyer and all fees will be charged to the buyer. Neighbors, Inc. will determine the minimum and maximum number of duck adoptions sold and entered into the race. All entry sections must be filled out completely and clearly and delivered to the Presenter or an authorized representative to be eligible to win any aforementioned prize. Parents/guardians are required to sign up for all adoptees under 18 years of age.
- 3. A number will be put on each duck that will relate to the adoption certificate. All ducks entered will be made available by Neighbors, Inc. and remain the property of Neighbors, Inc. Multiple duck adoptions may relate to one Duck Code certificate. Once the ducks are put in the water, they will not be touched or interfered with. Excess ducks may be in the race. Any duck without a number passing the finish line will be disregarded when discerning winning ducks. The entry's name, which appears on the adoption certificate, will be matched with their adopted duck and the first three ducks to finish each race and the last duck to finish the final race will win prizes, as judged by a Neighbors' Representative.
- 4. Ducks will be launched from Neighbors' booth in South St. Paul throughout the event on October 3, 2015. The chance of winning depends on the total number of qualified entries. Winners will be publicly announced at the finish of each race after the tabulation of the results. If a winner does not claim his or her prize within 30 days of the race date, said prize will be forfeited. No cash equivalent prizes will be provided as a replacement for the designated prizes. Any and all sales or income taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Winners are not required to be present to win. Winners will be posted on website. Prizes won by ducks designated to Neighbors will be given to the Neighbors holiday program to distribute.
- 5. In the case of bad weather, technical issues or other acts of God, Neighbors, Inc. reserves the right to postpone the race upon announcement, or choose the winners through another means. Neighbors, Inc. shall not be held liable in any way for any loss, damage, or inconvenience.
