### Celebrating 50 Years of Service



Fifty years ago, volunteers from six churches came together and were determined to help their neighbors through a local crisis. They set up shop in churches and homes. They gathered food and clothing and gave it away. They gave gifts at Christmas to children who otherwise would have none. They called their neighbors to check in and see how they were doing. Neighbors grew into a larger organization with a wider reach. We began expanding our services including providing rides to medical and other essential appointments. With the help of volunteers, we sponsored social events for people with disabilities. We celebrated together at events and luncheons. Neighbors grew some more and through it all exemplified one of the founding organizational principles: love thy neighbor as thy self.

Throughout its history, Neighbors has evolved to meet the needs of the day. While we are taking time to celebrate, it is also important to recognize that the need for Neighbors still exists. One of the ways we are currently mitigating the effects of poverty is by investing in our newest program, Financial Empowerment. This program will focus on improving the financial well-being of the people we serve by connecting them to safe financial resources. We continue to focus on hunger relief and providing essential items through our Clothes Closet Thrift Store.

You are invited to join us on September 16 from 4PM to 7PM and September 17 from 10AM to 3PM at an open house at our building located at 222 Grand Avenue West in South St. Paul. On Friday night, we will have live music, hot dogs and a beer garden. Saturday we will have food trucks, a fashion show and games for the kids (and adults). Both days there will be tours of our building where you will see our remodeled food shelf, new Financial Empowerment Center and the unveiling of a mural commemorating fifty years of Neighbors. ### **Neighbors' Impact**

The Ramirez\* family welcomed two daughters in two years! Both husband and wife are college educated. Even with a good salary and insurance, the family got behind on medical bill payments and went to collections. Working with our financial counselors, they learned their two children are eligible for both Medical Assistance and WIC. They set up a payment plan with the hospital and created a plan to pay off the existing debts. They now visit the food shelf monthly to create a little room in their budget to meet their debt reduction goals. \*Names and identifying information changed.

### **Saturday Food Distributions**



The third Saturday of each month, our food shelf holds a free "bonus" food distribution event. These food distributions are a way the people we serve can access additional healthy food options. Last month, we served 222 individuals through this distribution. Distributions occur from 10AM—noon. The next distribution will be held on October 15. No advance sign-up is required. Distributions are open to people experiencing need in our community.
