NEIGHBORS PARTNERS WITH HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Neighbors' Financial Empowerment Program has been helping clients in our Financial Empowerment Center for the past year. As the program gains momentum, we continue to build partnerships with other helping organizations to add to the suite of services we offer. One of the newest organizations Neighbors has partnered with is Habitat for Humanity. Purchasing a Habitat Home allows a homeowner the opportunity of an affordable monthly mortgage payment. Eligibility for a Habitat Home is dependent upon income, credit score and savings. If someone wants to apply through this program but does not meet the established parameters, Neighbors is one of only 15 referral partners in the Twin Cities Metro who can help get the buyer "Habitat Ready." Through Neighbors' Financial Empowerment Program, participants are provided with quality homebuyer educational materials and given the tools, knowledge and encouragement to build healthy credit and savings.



Interested participants can schedule an appointment with one of our financial counselors by calling Neighbors at 651-455-5000. We would be happy to discuss all Habitat for Humanity requirements and either assist with the application or create a plan to improve homebuyer eligibility.
